MEDICAL MARIJUANA CONSULTING AND PHYSICIAN CLINIC OPEN FOR FLORIDA PATIENTS

***Staff Expanded at West Palm Beach Location;
Amendment 2 to Appear on November Ballot;
Patients Urged to Begin Process Early***

February 3, 2016 – West Palm Beach, FL – Liberate Medical Marijuana Services, Florida’s first clinic offering services that will be required for patients to have legal access under Amendment 2, announced today that it has expanded its staff, including the addition of Michael Jacobs as General Manager.

Jacobs has worked in politics for three decades and has been a medical marijuana activist since 1988 as a coordinator for the Cannabis Action Network. In addition to his work supporting the signature drive for Amendment 2 in Florida, he was also involved in similar for as Colorado approved both medical and recreational marijuana.

Last week, the Florida’s Division of Elections officially certified Amendment 2 placing the proposed amendment of the state constitution on the November 2016 ballot. A similar ballot initiative was narrowly defeated in 2014. Organizers of the 2016 amendment say they have tightened-up the language and taken into account concerns previously voiced by opponents
